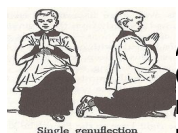

THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY



Caring for Creation: *Did you know* ticks and mosquitoes are God's creatures? They humbly remind me, that God is all knowing and I, a mere mortal, have no idea why He created them. Let's start with the ticks. Forget vampire bats sucking your blood, they are not around here. Blood suckers like the Dog Tick, Lone Star, Groundhog and Deer Ticks are out waiting for you. They do not fly or jump on you. They can be found on tips of tall grasses and shrubs with their rear legs outstretched waiting for you or some other animal to pass by that they can latch on to. The native mosquitoes commonly found here are usually most active in the early morning hours and late evening. Now, thanks to the Invasive Asian Tiger Mosquito we are no longer safe during the middle of the day when they are active.

Ticks, which rarely cause death, do carry many serious health risks associated with their bites. Think Lime Disease among many others. As for our Mosquito friends, over a million people die globally of mosquito born diseases every year. What to do? In areas that you control, keep grass short for tick control. For mosquitos, empty standing water everywhere around your home. Places to watch include tires, gutters, plant trays, pet bowls and bird baths which should be flushed clean every other day. ***I do not recommend any insecticide sprays for the treatment of the landscape!*** It only takes a few days from the time the eggs are laid that new adult mosquitoes will emerge looking for a meal. 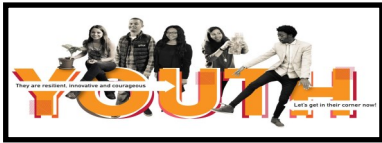
