The Second Sunday of Advent



Introduction:

God sent John the Baptist to prepare the people for the coming of his son. The message he preached then is just as important today, as we prepare ourselves for the coming of our savior, Jesus Christ.

OPENING PRAYER




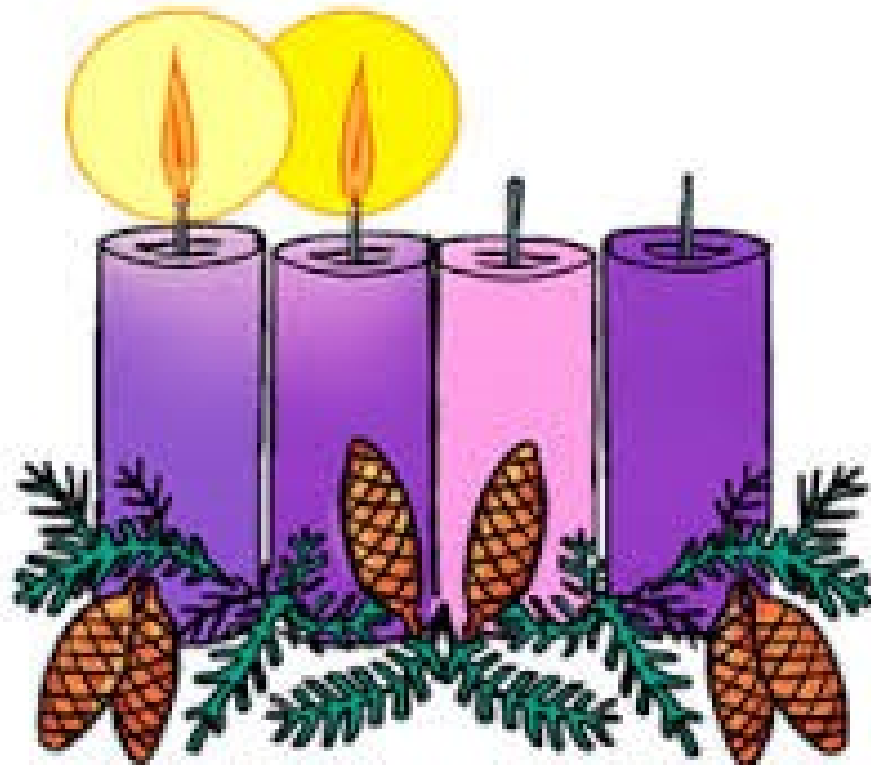
Light a Candle and say this together:

As we light our candles today, the words of the prophet Isaiah remind us that Jesus is the light of the world: Those who walked in darkness have seen a wonderful light. The light which shines on them chases the shadows of darkness away from

GOSPEL:
MARK 1:1-8

The prophet Isaiah foretold that God would send a messenger to prepare the people for the Lord's coming. This messenger was John the Baptist, who appeared in the desert telling the people to be sorry for their sins and to make a fresh start in their lives. Many people heard his message and came to be baptized as a sign of their change of heart. John told them, "Someone is coming who is more powerful than me, and I am not good enough to undo the straps of his sandals. I baptize you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit."
