Sixth Sunday of Easter

Introduction:

As Jesus shared the Last Supper with his apostles, he told them that soon he would be leaving them. They were frightened and upset by his words, but he promised to send someone to help them. He would not leave them on their own.



OPENING PRAYER



Light a Candle and say this prayer:

Lord, as we light our candles, we think about the brightness of their light which reminds us of God's glory.

Amen.

GOSPEL:

JOHN 14: 16-20

One day Jesus said to his disciples, “I will not leave you on your own; I will ask my father to send you a helper who will stay with you always. The spirit of God will be with you and in you, though others will not be able to see him or know that he is there. He will fill you with wisdom and understanding. Soon the world will not see me again, but you will know that I am truly alive.





Discussion

Whom did Jesus promise to send to his disciples?

A special helper: the Holy Spirit.

What would this helper look like?

Jesus told them: “Others will not be able to see him or know that he is there.”

Why did Jesus send the Holy Spirit?

God sent his spirit to the apostles to begin the teaching of the Gospel throughout the world.

When do we receive the Holy Spirit in a special way?

At our baptism and confirmation.
