

Feast of the Pentecost

Introduction:

Today is Pentecost, which the Jews celebrated fifty days after the Passover. Today we celebrate the birthday of the Church and hear how Jesus sent his Holy Spirit to the disciples, just as he had promised to do.



OPENING PRAYER



Light a Candle and say this prayer:

Jesus said, "Let your goodness shine
out like a light in the darkness, so that
through you, the love of our heavenly
father will touch the lives of others."

GOSPEL: ACTS 2:1-42

The disciples had gathered together in Jerusalem to celebrate the feast of Pentecost. As they were praying together, the room was suddenly filled with the sound of a powerful wind which roared through the house. Then, what looked like small tongues of fire appeared and spread out to touch each one of them. So it was that they were filled with the Holy Spirit.

Now the spirit lived inside them, and they would never feel alone.



Discussion

Imagine you are a disciple sitting quietly ...what did you hear?

A sudden furious wind, gusting through the room.

How did the Spirit change the disciples?

He filled them with courage and power so that they could stand up before the crowds and preach and work miracles in God's name.

When do we receive the Holy Spirit in a special way?

He comes to us first at baptism, and then his power is refreshed in us at confirmation.


COLORING PAGES
