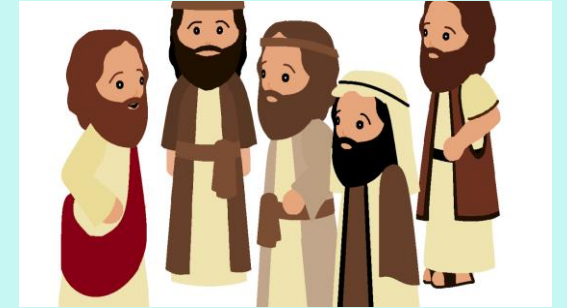

The Twenty-Third Sunday of Ordinary Time



Introduction:

Today Jesus reminds us that he will be with us in a very special way every time we meet together to pray.

OPENING PRAYER



Light a Candle and have the children say
the following :

May the light of Jesus fill our lives.

GOSPEL:

MATTHEW 18: 18-20

Jesus said to his disciples, “Listen to me: whatever you accept on earth, will be accepted in heaven; and whatever you forbid on earth, will be forbidden in heaven. When two of you agree to ask for something, then my father will answer your prayers. Again I tell you, that when two or three of you meet together in my name, then I will be there with you.”





Discussion

How many of us have gathered here today?

Do you think that the Holy Spirit is here with us now?

Can you think of other times when two or more people gather together to pray?

Jesus told us that when only a few people meet together in his name, then he promises to be with them.
