~ *Pastor's Note* ~

Archbishop William Lori visited our parish last Saturday, June 17th and celebrated a joyous Vigil Mass with some 200 parishioners! Following the Mass, the Archbishop gathered and talked with parishioners at the reception in Unity Hall.

I thank the many persons who worked together to prepare for the Mass and the reception - the members of our Liturgy Committee; all who served at the Mass; Ron Brown and the members of the Liturgical Choir; Laura Benso and the parishioners who prepared delicious foods for the reception; and the members of our Parish Staff who assisted with the Mass and reception. I share with you some pictures on page 6 of this bulletin (left column) of Archbishop Lori's pastoral visit. See additional pictures on our Facebook page and parish website.

I share with you an update on our HVAC Campaign. As of this past Sunday, June 18th, we have received \$72,932.12. These gifts, combined with the \$50,000 from our reserve fund, gives us a total of \$122,932.12 or 19.5% towards our goal of \$630,000! We are tracking our parish's progress in our HVAC Campaign with the two red thermometers in our narthex. The thermometers are on the two brick walls on the far right or left of the double doors that lead into our Church.

Every dollar given during this two year campaign is cathedraticum free, which means every dollar will go toward the purchase and installation of our new HVAC System. If you would like to make your contribution thru Faith Direct, you can contribute to the maintenance collection on Faith Direct. If you would like assistance in choosing this option for the campaign, feel free to call the Parish Office. Thank you for your support!

With summer vacations beginning, we will start our summer Mass schedule starting the weekend of July 1st & 2nd thru August 26th & 27th. The Mass schedule will be as follows: **Saturday Vigil Mass - 5pm, Sunday Masses - 8:30am & 10:30am.** On the first weekend in September we will return to our regular Mass schedule.

At the start of the Covid Pandemic, the sharing of the Precious Blood of Jesus Christ was stopped. Starting next month in July, the sharing of the second species will be offered at all weekend Masses. If you have a cold or are feeling under the weather, I would ask you to not receive from the chalice.
