Answer to the question about "Nihil Obstat": It is the Latin phrase that literally

means "nothing hinders." It is a certification that a book has been examined and found to contain nothing opposed to faith and morals. The bishop of the author's diocese or of the place of publication (such as a publishing company) gives the final approval and it is usually accompanied by the declaration known as the *imprimatur* ("let it be printed").
