DEACON DOUG'S Q & A: One of the strengths of Holy Family as a parish is the fact that many of its prominent features are "homemade." Can you name two of the most prominent features in the worship space that were made by parishioners?

Answer to last week's question: A reredos is a decorative screen above and behind the altar

but structurally separate from the altar. The tabernacle is held in the reredos. In many older and large Churches, especially in Europe, the reredos often covered the wall, and might be extravagantly decorated with statue niches, painted panels, and highly carved stone or wood pinnacles. The wooden reredos in our Church was built and positioned in 2003.
