The Nineteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time

Introduction:

Over the past two weeks we have heard how God feeds his people and takes care of their needs. Today we listen to a story about the prophet Elijah, who lay weak with hunger, feeling totally hopeless, until God saved him.

OPENING PRAYER



Light a Candle and have the children read

the following prayer:

Lord, at our baptism we became children of the light.

Help that light to shine out in our lives,

So that others will be touched by the love and faith

which you have given to us.

GOSPEL: KINGS 19:1-8

The prophet Elijah listened to God and told the people what God had said. A man called Ahab was King of Israel at that time, and he did not believe in God. After Elijah and the king had a great argument, Elijah escaped to the desert, because he was afraid that the king would have him killed. After walking for a whole day under the glare of the desert sun, Elijah sat down under a shady bush and said "I can't go on, Lord! I have had enough and just want to die in peace!"

He fell asleep, until an angel woke him and said, "Elijah, have something to eat and drink." Beside him he saw a loaf of bread and a jar of water. He ate and drank and then fell asleep again. This happened a second time, and finally Elijah got up, and feeling much better, carried on with his journey.



Discussion

Why did Elijah feel so fed up?

He had argued with King Ahab and upset him, and he believed that the king might have him killed.

When you are hungry and thirsty, how does it make you feel?

We can swim in water, and we can lie and float on water; but if we try to stand without anything to make us float, we only sink.
