The Third Sunday of the Year



Introduction:

Jesus called the first disciples to follow him, and they left everything and went with him. Today each of us is called to follow Jesus by sharing God's love with everyone as he taught us to do.

GOSPEL: MARK 1:14-20

After John the Baptist had been arrested by Herod, Jesus began to preach to the crowds and proclaim the good news. One day, while walking beside the sea of Galilee, he saw Simon Peter and his brother Andrew casting their nets to catch fish.

Jesus called out to them, "Come, follow me and I will make you fishers of people." The

brothers left their nets and followed him. Further along the shore Jesus saw James and his brother, John, who were mending nets with their father Zebedee. Jesus called them, too, and at once they left their father and followed him.









Discussion

Who were the brothers who left their boats and nets to follow Jesus?

They were Simon Peter and Andrew, James and John.

Many people followed Jesus and became his disciples, but Jesus chose a small number of them to carry on his work. How Many did he choose, and can you remember some of the names?

Jesus chose twelve apostles. The name "apostle" was given to a follower of Jesus who had been specially chosen. Simon Peter, Andrew, James, John, Philip, Bartholomew, Matthew, Thomas, (another) James, Thaddaeus, Simon, and Judas.
