# The Seventeenth Sunday of Ordinary Time



## **Introduction:**

Today Jesus tells us a story to explain that the kingdom of heaven is like a priceless treasure that we would swap our most precious possessions for.

#### **OPENING PRAYER**

I, the Lord, will be your everlasting light and my glory will shine on you always.

Isaiah 60:19

## **GOSPEL**:

#### MATTHEW 13: 44-46

Jesus said to the crowds, "One day a man was digging in a field when his spade struck a box which was buried there. When he opened the box he was amazed to find it was full of treasure. He quickly buried the treasure again, went away, and sold his house and all that he owned with the money he made, he bought the field from the farmer, and then ran back and dug up the treasure.

"There was another man who was a merchant who bought and sold pearls to earn a living. One day he happened to find the most perfect, beautiful pearl he had ever seen. He, too, went away and sold everything so that he would have enough money to buy that pearl himself."

Jesus said, "God's kingdom is a real treasure, as perfect and precious as the pearl; you would give up everything you have for it, because it is worth more than anything else in the whole world."



## **Discussion**

Do you have something which is very precious to you, which you treasure more than anything else?

It might be a toy, a book, a favorite teddy, or some item which is not important to other people but means a great deal to you.

Do you treat your treasure carefully because it means so much to you?

Jesus wanted us to understand that God's love for us is like a priceless treasure. It means more than any possession we have on earth; it is worth giving up everything we own to have it.

What must we do to find the treasure of God's kingdom?

By living as Jesus taught us and following his example, we will have God's love which is worth more than all our worldly posessions.
