The Fourteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time

Introduction:

In the time of Jesus, Nazareth was a little town in the hill country of Galilee. Jesus spent his childhood there living with his parents Mary and Joseph. During a return visit to Nazareth he found that he was not welcome anymore.

OPENING PRAYER



Light a Candle and say this prayer:


As we light our candles today, let us remember the words of Jesus:

"I am the light of the world; whoever follows me will have the light of life and will never walk in darkness." —

John 8:12

GOSPEL:MARK 6:1-6

Jesus returned to his hometown of Nazareth with his disciples, and on the Sabbath Day, he went to the synagogue to preach. The people there were amazed by his wisdom and all that he said, and many of them had heard of the miracles that he had worked. But some of the crowd asked, "Isn't this the son of Joseph the carpenter? Isn't his family still living here in Nazareth? How can he know all these things and talk in this way?" They would not listen to Jesus or believe in him. Jesus was saddened and disappointed by their lack of faith, and he left Nazareth to go and preach elsewhere.







Discussion

Jesus came from the town of Nazareth. Why were the people there amazed by the adult Jesus?

What did Jesus do when the Nazareth people did not believe him?

Many of them had grown up with Jesus, gone to school together, and worshipped with him at the synagogue every week. They knew him as Jesus, the ordinary son of an ordinary couple, Mary and Joseph. Jesus of Nazareth was no longer a carpenter's son.

Jesus left Nazareth and traveled from place to place, bringing his message to those who were willing to listen and believe that he was indeed the son of God.
