The Thirteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time



Introduction:

Imagine if you met Jesus today, if he suddenly arrived at your house and rang the doorbell. When you realized who this “stranger” really was, what would you do and say to welcome him? Jesus wants us to treat everyone as we would treat him.

OPENING PRAYER



Light a Candle and say this prayer:

The path to our heavenly Father is like the sun rising, getting brighter and brighter as we draw closer to God. Those who turn away from his love, follow a path as dark as the night, and they stumble and fall as they cannot see the way.

Proverbs 4:18-19

GOSPEL:

MATTHEW 10:40-42

Jesus said to his apostles: “Anyone who makes you feel welcome in their homes, is welcoming me, for I am with you always. Anyone who treats you kindly and shares their food and drink with you, is sharing their goodness with me and my father who sent me. However small or great their act of kindness, they will be rewarded for their goodness.”





Discussion

What does it mean to welcome someone?

It means to greet someone with pleasure and friendliness, and to make them feel that you are pleased to see them.

How do you welcome anyone who comes to visit your home?

In today's Gospel, what message did Jesus give us?

Whenever we welcome anyone and treat them kindly, then we are welcoming Jesus .

We pray to the Lord.

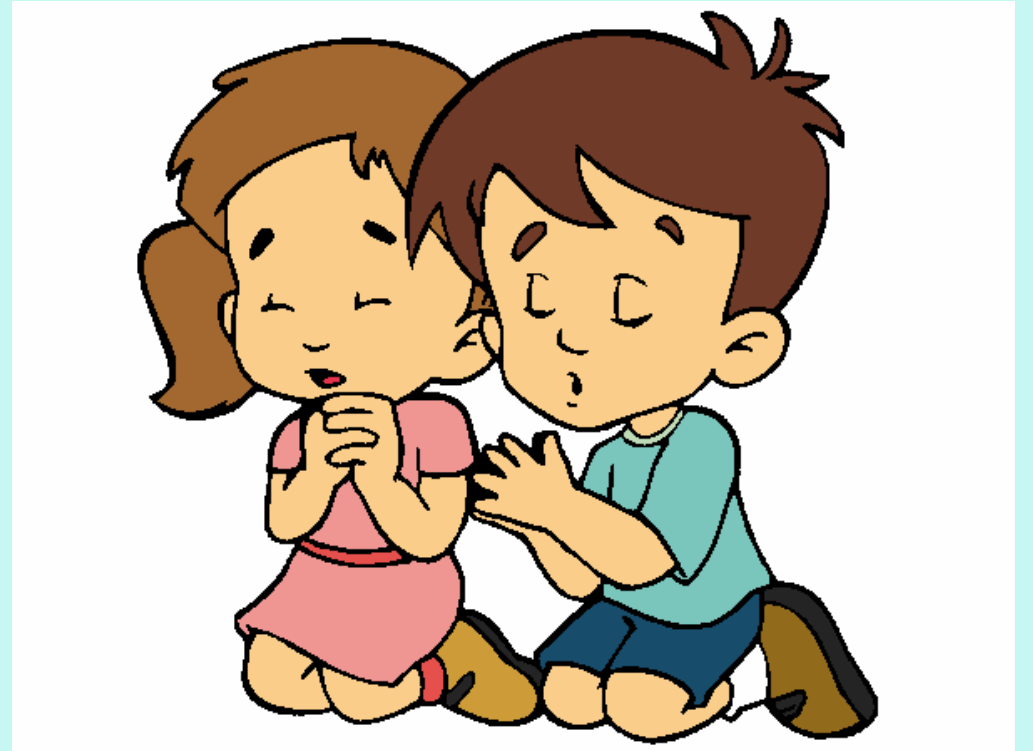
Lord, hear our prayer.
