Feast of the Trinity

Introduction:

God shares himself with us through the three persons of the Trinity. We share the love of God the Father, the goodness of Jesus the Son, and the friendship of the Holy Spirit.



OPENING PRAYER



Light a Candle and say this prayer: As we light our candles today, we thank God the Father for sending Jesus, his son, to rescue us from sin, and the Holy Spirit who will always be our friend.

GOSPEL: MATTHEW 28:16-20

Jesus appeared to his disciples on a hillside where they had arranged to meet. When they saw him they fell to their knees and he said to them, "All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me, and I am sending you out into the world to make disciples of all peoples. Baptize them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teach them to obey all the commandments I have given to you. Remember that I will always be with you, to the very end of time."



Discussion

Who are the three persons who make up the Holy Trinity?

God, the Father; Jesus, the Son; God, the Holy Spirit.


Visual idea to share: God is like a child with three hats. Only one God, but according to what "job" he is doing, and what "hat" he is wearing, God is known as the Father, Son or Holy Spirit.


COLORING PAGES
