## The Thirty-First Sunday of Ordinary Time

### **Introduction:**

The Pharisees were the leaders of the Jewish people.

They studied the scriptures and were very proud that

they obeyed the Jewish Law. The ordinary people looked

to the Pharisees for good example, but Jesus told his

followers that they did not practice what they preached.



#### **OPENING PRAYER**

Jesus, help us to listen to your word today.


And let the light of your love shine out

### **GOSPEL:**MATTHEW 23:1–12

Jesus said to the crowds, "Listen to what the Pharisees tell you and do what they say, but do not copy what they do. They do not put their words into actions or practice what they preach. They are full of self-importance and pride, and you must not follow their example. Only God is important, and you must be ready to serve him and one another."







### **Discussion**

Jesus said that the Pharisees did not practice what they preached. What does this mean? It means that the Pharisees did not match what they said with what they did.

Can you think of examples in everyday life when people don't "practice what they preach?"
