The Thirty-Second Sunday of Ordinary Time

Introduction:

It is easy to be ready for something to happen when we know the day and time to expect it. Today Jesus explains that we must always be ready for his return, even though no one knows when he will be coming.



OPENING PRAYER



Light a Candle and say this together:

Jesus, help us to listen to your word today.

And let the light of your love shine out

like these candles, touching the lives of

everyone we meet.

GOSPEL:

MATTHEW 25:1-13

One day Jesus told this parable: “Ten bridesmaids were getting ready for a wedding, and together they went to greet the bridegroom. They were not sure when he would come or how long they would have to wait. Five of them were sensible girls who bought flasks of oil to refill their lamps, the other girls did not. The bride groom was late, and after waiting all afternoon and all evening, the bridesmaids finally fell asleep. It was already midnight when somebody cried, ‘The bridegroom is coming! Quickly go and greet him!’ The wise bridesmaids refilled their lamps and went to meet him, but the lamps of the foolish girls had gone out, and they had to go off to buy more oil. When they returned the bridegroom and the five bridesmaids had already gone into the wedding hall.”

Why does Jesus tell us this story?

So that we will always be ready for his return.

How can we keep ourselves ready for when Jesus returns?
