#### **OPENING PRAYER**




Light a Candle and say this together:

#### MATTHEW 22:1-14

The king was furious and said to his servants, 'These people do not deserve to share in my party, so go out and invited everyone you meet. They can come to the wedding instead!' Soon, the hall was filled with people, good and bad alike. The king noticed one man who had not bothered to dress for the occasion. He sent for his servants and the man was thrown out into the dark."







### **Discussion**

Why was the man at the end of the story asked to leave?




#### **COLORING PAGES**
