The Twenty-Ninth Sunday of Ordinary Time

Introduction:

Everything we have was given to us by God, who gives us love with unending generosity. How often do we remember to say "thank you" or to return just a little of what we have been given.



OPENING PRAYER



Light a Candle and say this together:


If we keep our eyes on the light, we need never feel afraid. Jesus will walk before us, guiding us through life towards the kingdom of heaven.

GOSPEL: MATTHEW 22:15-21

The Pharisees wanted to trick Jesus into saying something which would get him into trouble. So they went to him and said, "We know that you are honest and are not afraid to speak the truth. Tell us then, should we give our money to the Romans or to God?"

Jesus answered, "Why do you want to trick me? Show me your money." They gave him a Roman denarius and he asked them, "Who is the person on this coin?" "Caesar," they answered.

Then Jesus said, "Give back to Caesar what belongs to him, and give to God what is God's."







Discussion

Did Jesus tell the people to stop giving their money in taxes to the Romans?

What do you think Jesus wanted the people to give to God?

Jesus answered this trick question wisely. He told the people to give back to Caesar what belonged to him, but at the same time, to give back to God what belonged to God.

He wanted them to return the love which God gave them.
