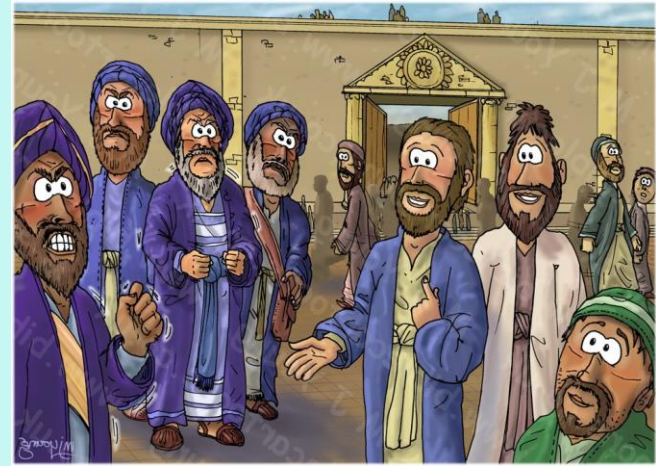

Love God with all your might. Love your neighbor as yourself.



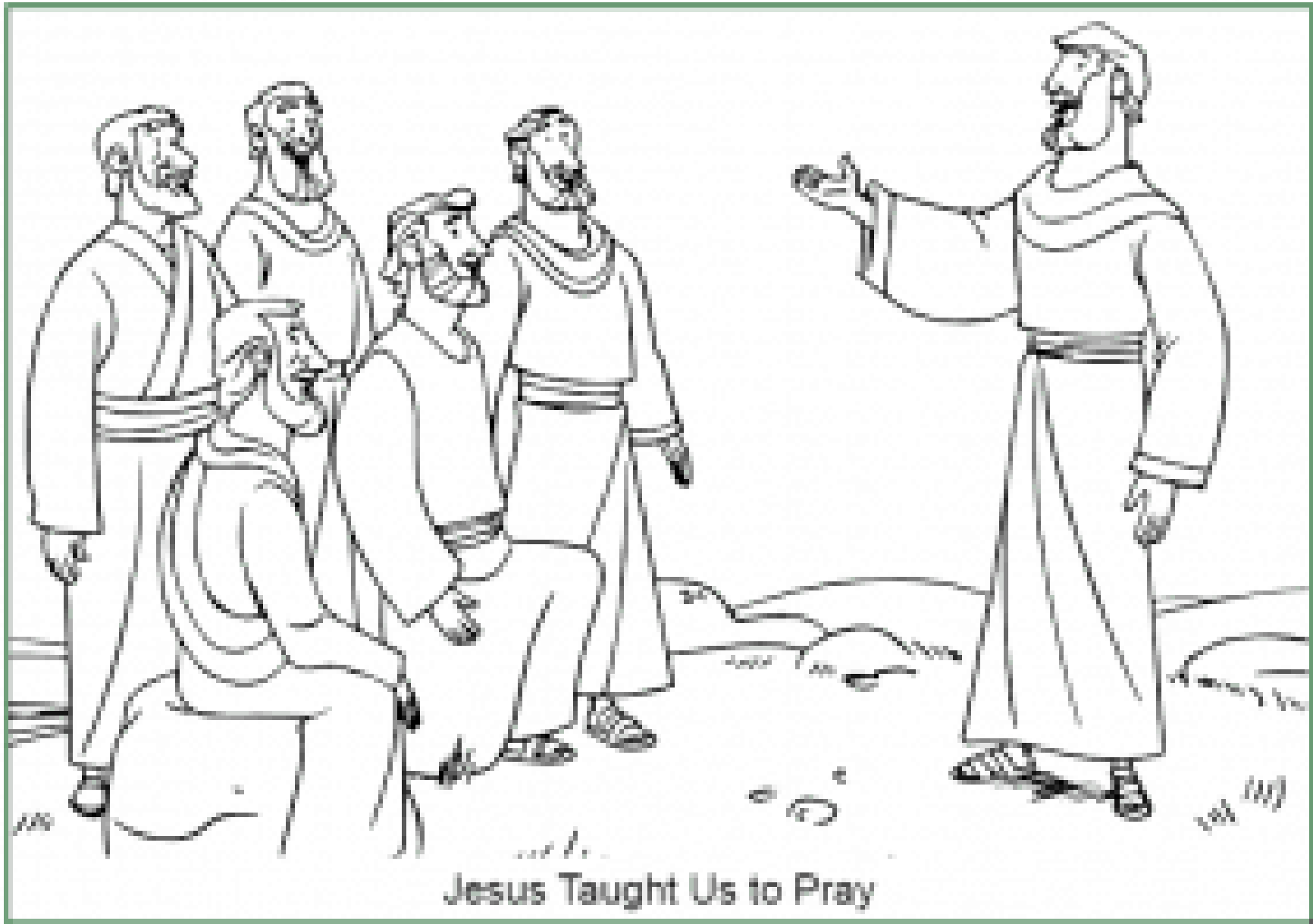
