Question: Our stained-glass windows are not a traditional style. Is there a theme that ties them together?

Answer to the question why celebrate the Ascension: It is a feast of the kingship of Christ and the final redemptive act that gives participation in the divine life to all who are members of Christ. It is the completion of the Easter mysteries of Jesus' life, passion, death and resurrection, and it is the final step before the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. That is the task the Apostles began to do, starting with prayer in the upper room as they awaited the promised Holy Spirit.
