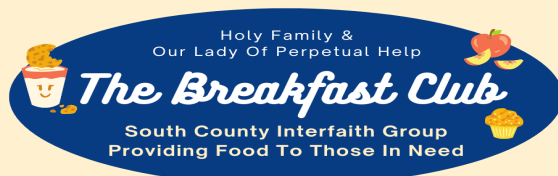
Deacon Doug's Q&A

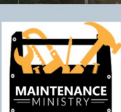
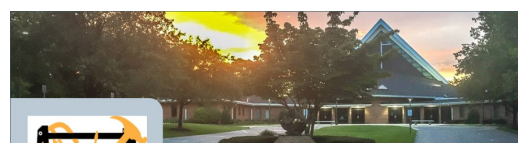
