

This little hawk fledgling was in our neighbor's yard. One baby was picked up by Owl Moon Raptor Rehabilitation already. It was described as severely malnourished. They came back the next day as two more were found on the ground. The parents were

trying to bring food as best they could. The problem was, we have a family of foxes around as well.

So, all three fledglings have now been picked up. The rehabilitator drove twice, all the way from northern Montgomery County in Boyds, Maryland to do this special ministry. We expect them to survive and will be returned to our area of the forest.

#### Deacon Doug's Q&A

**Question:** Last Thursday, Fr. Mike participated in the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage that stopped at Mount St. Mary's in Emmitsburg. What is the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage?

Answer to the question about permanent deacons permitted to marry: Simple answer is yes. Canon Law states the men already married may be ordained as permanent deacons. Unmarried men, however, must take a vow of celibacy, while married deacons who are widowed may not, in accordance with traditional Church discipline, enter into marriage.
